

# PUBLIC NOTICE

The MURFREESBORO WATERWORKS is a public water system subject to regulation under the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act. Those regulations require the notification of customers whenever a violation occurs, and is the basis for this notice.

Only 2 of the required 3 valid bacteriological sample results, were received during July 2025.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sets drinking water standards and has determined that the presence of total coliforms is a possible health concern.

The water system did not conduct the required monitoring or obtain valid results for total coliform bacteria during this time period and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of the drinking water at the time.

Failure to meet this requirement does not necessarily mean that the water is unsafe or that alternate sources of water should be used.

The water system has submitted all of the required bacteriological samples prior to and after July 2025. All samples taken were found to be in compliance with the drinking water standards set forth by the United States Environments Protection Agency.
