## **RESOLUTION NO. 2023-7**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MURFREESBORO, ARKANSAS ADOPTING THE PIKE COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS the City of Murfreesboro recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Murfreesboro, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS the City of Murfreesboro has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Pike County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS The Pike County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property of the City of Murfreesboro from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the City of Murfreesboro demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Pike County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MURFREESBORO, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City of Murfreesboro resolves to adopt the Pike County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. While content related to the City of Murfreesboro may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the City of Murfreesboro to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
