A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AN ARKANSAS COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE GRANT

Be it resolved by the City Council of Murfreesboro, State of Arkansas, a resolution entitled: Community Assistance Grant Application for the removal and replacement of windows and installation of overhead doors equipped with electrical operators and remotes in the City of Murfreesboro Fire Department.

A resolution authorizing the Mayor of Murfreesboro to apply for a grant on behalf of the Murfreesboro Fire Department and the City of Murfreesboro.

Whereas the Murfreesboro City Council has determined that the City of Murfreesboro Fire Department meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Community Grant Program, and


Whereas, the City of Murfreesboro has presented plans to remove and dispose of existing windows and overhead doors and purchase the necessary materials, and the install five (5) insulated overhead doors, and seven (7) insulated picture windows in the Murfreesboro Fire Department whereas, the City Council of Murfreesboro recognizes the need for the project, concurs with its importance, and supports the City of Murfreesboro Fire Department in its efforts to proceed with the same, and

Whereas, the City of Murfreesboro Fire Department has furnished proof that they have raised \$8,068.76 through community cash and/or in-kind donations to be applied to the project as a local match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of Murfreesboro is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission for the purpose of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$32,275.02 to aid and assist the City of Murfreesboro Fire Department in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor of Murfreesboro is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
